



# Waste sorting and recycling in Fjellregionen

## Sorting at home

 <p><b>Green lid</b> <b>Compostable</b></p>	 <p><b>Blue lid</b> <b>Paper and cardboard</b></p>	 <p><b>Turquoise lid</b> <b>Glass- and metal-packaging</b></p>	 <p><b>Grey lid</b> <b>Garbage</b></p>	 <p><b>Clear bag</b> <b>Plastic Packaging</b></p>
<p>For food that cannot be eaten, including paper towel with food waste on it, coffee grinds, tea bags, eggshells and other food waste without wrapping.</p> 	<p>All kinds of paper, both writing paper, newspapers, milk and juice cartons, flyers, cardboard packaging and paper filler.</p> 	<p>Clean glass and metal of any foodstuffs.</p> 	<p>Garbage is what is left after you have removed anything that could be sorted into other bins. For example diapers, vacuum bags, tobacco, and contaminated plastic.</p> 	<p>Plastic packaging is a plastic that has wrapped food and other items.</p> 
<p>Food waste goes exclusively in green bags. Tie the bag with two knots and put in the bin.</p>	<p>Juice and milk cartons should be rinsed with cold water and drip-dried.</p>	<p>Rinse with cold water and air-dry. Put the glass and metal in the bin as is.</p>	<p>Place in a regular plastic bag, tie with a knot to avoid spilling.</p>	<p>Put these items in the clear FIAS-sekk. Rinse with cold water and put them in the bag as is.</p>
